THE ELDER (V.O.)

Nick of NICK'S SCI-FI CORNER. We the Elders of the Universe have summoned you here for a great purpose.

NICK

(BUG-EYED) What? I just came here to pick up my order for dinner. What purpose?

THE ELDER (V.O.)

We cannot tell you at this time. All
we can say is that you will be
transported to a far away place full
of magic and mystery where science and
the supernatural are one and the same.
It is a place that will defy human
logic and all explanation. And you
must rise to the task we have set
forth -- or all could be lost.

NICK

Oh my god! Why me? Surely there must be a real hero out there that is better suited to this great quest.

THE ELDER (V.O.)

The real hero lies within us all.

Plus, you have the spirit of a true
champion for this cause. Are you

NICK

THOR STOPS AS NICK BEAMS IN. HE IS JUST AS SURPRISED AS NICK IS.

NICK

(LOOKS AT T-SHIRT). What? (LOOKS AT CLAWS) What? (TOUCHES BEARD) Oh my god! (TURNS AROUND, SEES CONVENTION CENTER) Hah? (SEES EXTRAS) You there, Where am i?

THOR

San Diego Comic-Con man.

NICK

What? San Diego Comic-Con? Really?

THOR

Yeah!

NICK

What year is this?

THOR

Dude, it's two thousand fourteen. Where have you been?

NTCK

Oh my god! This was the most pivotal year of San Diego Comic-Con ever!

THOR

NICK SITS DOWN EITHER AT THE MARINA OR ON SOMEWHERE NEARBY THE CONVENTION CENTER (MAYBE NEAR THE 25FT TALL GODZILLA) THAT'S QUIET ENOUGH TO DO THE SEGMENT BUT STILL ACTIVE ENOUGH TO BE A PART OF SDCC.

NOTE: Any starred film title, cast member, scene, URL, etc will get a corresponding pop-up image or a SUPERIMPOSITION.

#### NICK

Hey, hey friends! Now it's time for a special edition of 'The Amazing Cinematograph!" Here at San Diego Comic-Con I've decided to do my genre movie review and film industry news segment a bit differently. Plus, I don't have my director's chair or megaphone with me anyway. Hahaha! And, I've invited some new friends of mine to help me out here. Plus, I have a surprise guest who will be joining me later to talk about what he's been upto in the film world and also to talk about Ridley Scott's Blade Runner.

NICK INTRODUCES THE SDCC GUESTS WITH HIM AND THANKS THEM FOR COMING ON THE SHOW.

NOTE: The parts with the guests can be filmed separately from the movie reviews so as not to tie them up time-wise.

NICK (CONTD)

Awesome! So what I'm gonna do is first give my "quick and clean" thoughts on a couple of the big summer tentpole films out this year and then I'll let my friends chime in. First, we'll do CAPTAIN AMERICA: THE WINTER SOLDIER\* and then the grand 2014 American kaiju reboot GODZILLA\*! Let's get started!

BACK TO NICK

NICK (CONTD)

Yeah baby! This was awesome in a way I never expected! I'm personally giving this one a Super Nova!

SFX: ANIMATED SUPER NOVA IMAGE

NICK (CONTD)

The reason why I love this movie so much is that it is the most non-superhero movie for a Marvel superhero movie! Hahaha!

What I mean by that is that this film is much more like a political thriller than your typical summer (or midspring when this was released) action flick with capes and cowls. Starting with Captain America, Steve Rogers\* himself played beautifully by Chris Evans. He really puts in an A-plus performance as a man not only struggling with being "out-of-time" (after having been revived from a seventy-year hibernation in CAPTAIN AMERICA: THE FIRST AVENGER\*) but also with the grays and shadows of a political landscape that is so not the black and white/good and evil world of the Second World War from whence he came. And things get so out of control so fast, he both physically fights enemies and fights to maintain his integrity and beliefs from a relentless fear-based malice that the people around him are just letting happen\* ["This is not freedom; (MORE)

it's fear." | -- especially after The Avengers\* rebuffed a massive alien invasion back in 2012! (THEN) There's no need to comment on the action in this film, simply because it is incredible! O-M-G! And I'll tell you. I have come to the conclusion that in the hands of Captain America, his vibranium shield\* is the ULTIMATE WEAPON! [NSFC logo - "No, not that one! Hahaha! Cap shield - That one!"] All the acting is top-notch. Samuel L. Jackson as Nick Fury\* really brings it in this one (he did in THE AVENGERS but exceeds it here). Robert Redford\* is simply the best non-superpowered antagonist that any Marvel film has ever had. You can't beat him! And Scarlett Johanson\* finally gets her moments to shine in spades in her role as Natasha Romanov/Black Widow. She's come a long way from IRONMAN 2\*! Anthony Mackie\* does a great job as Falcon, and everyone else just rocks it 110%! Especially, the Winter Soldier\* himself.

If you haven't seen this movie then block your ears because I'm throwing out a major spoiler here. Cap's ostensibly deceased comrade from W-Wtwo's Howling Commandos, Bucky Barnes\* (played by Sebastian Stan) is also resurrected now as Cap's greatest enemy. A guy who has the same strength as Steve Rogers plus a bionic arm! But what really makes this an amazing conflict between the two is that even though Steve Rogers finds out that the Winter Soldier is really his best friend, Barnes has no memory of Rogers and the friendship they once had. As Cap struggles to save millions of lives he's also trying NOT to kill his best friend, even though Barnes is definitely trying to kill him. But it gets sooooo complicated and intense. This kind of drama goes beyond just superhero popcorn fare. I cried. And like I said before, any movie that can do that deserves a super nova.

(THEN) Finally, I've gotta point out the incredible tie-in that this movie had with the A-B-C T-V show MARVEL's AGENTS OF S.H.I.E.L.D.\* Oh my God, literally, five days after CAPTAIN AMERICA: THE WINTER SOLDIER opened up in the theaters, everything that had been happening on AGENTS OF S.H.I.E.L.D. tied in directly to this film\* -- including the ending of both! They were happening in synchronicity so if you didn't see Cap in the theaters before the Tuesday night airing of the A-O-S episode titled, Turn, Turn, Turn you were out of luck. But what a daring move for both Marvel and A-B-C! Amazing! (THEN) I can't wait now for THE AVENGERS: AGE OF ULTRON\* opening next year on May first, and the premiere of season two of AGENTS OF S.H.I.E.L.D.\* this fall on September twenty-third! And of course MARVEL'S GUARDIANS OF THE GALAXY\* next week! Hahaha!

NICK TURNS TO HIS GUESTS.

NICK (CONTD)

So what do you guys think about CAPTAIN AMERICA: THE WINTER SOLDIER?

THEY DISCUS THE FILM. NICK ASKS EACH GUEST WHAT RATING THEY'D GIVE IT.

BACK TO NICK

NICK (CONTD)

The Big G\* is back baby! He stomps, he romps, and he rolls! That's actually the title of the next regular episode of NICK'S SCI-FI CORNER\*. Hahaha! Seriously, though this was the most highly anticipated kaiju (that is, monster) movie ever! I should know, I was beyond psyched for this. I even went to the preview night in 3D IMAX at the Jordan's IMAX\* theater in the Boston area. (THEN) And what did I get? A reminder to never get my expectations up so high that when a movie like GODZILLA\* doesn't meet them, no matter how good it might be, I am thoroughly disappointed. This movie was a mixed back of both awesome and frustration.

By now I'm sure a lot of you have seen it and have heard of the debates going back and forth on the net about the merits and disappointments of this film. I too have participated in these arguments. You see for me, like a lot of people, I was led to believe that this was going to be a totally different movie based on what the trailers depicted. Actually, it goes further back than that to when I was here at San Diego Comic-Con\* in 2012 when the big news was not the massive THE HOBBIT: AN UNEXPECTED JOURNEY\* panel in Hall H, where I waited in line for five hours to not get in, but the teaser\* for director Gareth Edwards'\* GODZLLA. Oh my God was I jealous of those who got in to see that teaser and not me. And last year here, upon pure chance I was able to get into the closed out Godzilla Experience\* when one of the producers of the venue just happened to be staying in my hotel and offered to get my friends and I in!

My mind was blown then, and I couldn't have been more psyched for GODZILLA\*. I even went back and watched a ton of TOHO Godzilla films\* I hadn't seen before on Crackle\*. (THEN) So here we are on May fifteen at the IMAX and I am beyond psyched. The film starts, and after a brief disaster scene involving who I thought would be the main protagonist (other than Godzilla himself), Joe Brody played by Bryan Cranston\* of BREAKING BAD fame, we get some melodramatic family stuff with I guess the so-called "real protagonist" of the film (and not Godzilla himself believe it or not but I'm getting to that), Ford Brody, played be Aaron Taylor-Johnson\* of KICK-ASS\* fame. And then after a big reveal of one of the monsters (a MUTO\*, that is a Massive Unidentified Terrestrial Organism) in the film (and not Godzilla himself, see where I'm going with this yet?), Cranston is out of the picture! Just like that.

And as soon as Godzilla himself shows up on the screen (like an hour into the film), he's gone too! What we get for the most part is a bevy of thinly developed human characters that really do nothing significant in either stopping the monster rampage or protecting their families from it -just a bunch of soldiers running around like chickens with their heads cut off. Everything that the trailers made it seem like the end of the world was nigh with the arrival of Godzilla\* was none of that in the actual film. (THEN) Now I get that Gareth Edwards was trying make JAWS\* out of GODZILLA. He was paying homage to Spielberg and the like by not revealing The Big G and his MUTO monster adversaries too soon or too much. But I think he completely missed the whole point of Godzilla to begin with. Godzilla is both an unstoppable force of nature and an underdog we all can root for.

In most of the TOHO Godzilla films he usually has his back up against a wall\* (metaphorically speaking that is), and that's when he rises to the challenge and kicks evil monster ass\*! (THEN) Yeah, I know, this is an American made film so we gotta go a bit Hollywood here on sappy dramaturgy but really Godzilla belongs to the world and being a guest star in his own movie was almost too much to bare! (THEN) That being said, I was also disappointed by the lack of use for Ken Watanabe's\* character as well. Watanabe in THE LAST SAMURAI\* as Katsumoto\* rocked! And in basically anything else he does. In this movie however, all he does is glare. His one sublime speech about Hiroshima was not enough to throw this great actor away. Him, Elizabeth Olsen\*, Sally Hawkins\*, David Strathairn\*, and Juliette Binoche\* are all criminally under-used and their talents simply wasted.

NICK (CONTD)

This movie should have been at least the Cranston/Watanabe\* show if it was going to be a Godzilla movie with the title character in it for only eleven minutes! (THEN) Gareth Edwards had \$160 million dollars to make this movie and though what we did see was phenomenal, that wasn't enough money to get a few more minutes of CGI kaiju action like we had in PACIFIC RIM\*? And yet four days after the movie was released, Edwards announced a sequel. Let's just hope that The King Of All Monsters\* finally gets his screen time due, or he should fire his agent with his radioactive breath!

What do I give this one? I'm torn between a red giant and a yellow sun. So I'm gonna ask my friends here to help me decide.

NICK (CONTD)

Well, there you have it! It's gonna be a ...

SFX: ANIMATION OF EITHER A RED GIANT OR A YELLOW SUN.
NICK THANKS HIS GUESTS.

CUT TO:

EXT. CONVENTION CENTER - SDCC - CONTINUOUS
 (NICK, DAN)

NICK AND DAN SIT TOGETHER.

NICK

Now I'm here with my buddy director, writer, and sometimes actor Daniel G. Thron. Thanks bro for coming on my show today here at SDCC!

DAN

No problem kid! Psyched to be here!

NICK

As you can see Dan and I go waaaay back to the when we used to argue over David Fincher's ALIEN 3\*! Hahaha! In fact, you can check out our Renegade Panel where we really get into it over JJ ABRAMS' STAR TREK INTO DARKNERSS.

NICK

INT. GREEN SCREEN SET - CONTINUOUS
 (NICK, EXTRAS)

NICK THEN RE-MATERIALIZES BACK IN THE CHAMBER. THE LIGHT FROM THE ELDERS SHINES UPON HIM ONCE AGAIN.

NICK

I'm back!

THE ELDER (V.O.)

We know, we brought you here,

remember?

NICK

Oh yeah. Sorry.

THE ELDER (V.O.)

Anyway, Nick of NICK'S SCI-FI CORNER,

you have successfully completed your

mission.

NICK

Which was what really?

THE ELDER (V.O.)

To help make the 2014 San Diego Comic-

Con the greatest one ever!

NICK

I did that?

THE ELDER (V.O.)

Sort of. Only time will tell.

NICK NOTICES AN OLDER GUY OFF IN THE CORNER BEHIND A SCREEN HOLDING SOMETHING.

NICK

Hey, who's that guy over there behind the screen!

THE ELDER (V.O.)

Oh he's just the janitor see.

THE GUY COMES INTO VIEW AND HE IS HOLDING A MOP.

NICK

Oh, sorry.

MUSIC CUE: THE MATRIX OF LEADERSHIP FROM 'TRANSFROMERS: REVENGE OF THE FALLEN'

THE ELDER (V.O.)

Now it is time to say goodbye.

NICK

Will I ever hear from The Elders of the Universe again?

THE ELDER

Someday perhaps, when the world needs us again. Now go forth and bring Sci-Fi to the world. It has always been your destiny ...

THE LIGHTS COME UP AND NICK IS SURROUNDED BY TON OF PEOPLE (MAYBE IN COSTUME), HIS FRIENDS, WHO CLAP AND CHEER!

NICK

Yeah!

FISH EYE LENS AND FREEZE FRAME AS NICK JUMPS INTO THE AIR WHEN HE SHOUTS.

FADE OUT.

END CREDITS

## END CREDITS SCENES THE MIRROR NSFC UNIVERSE!

FADE IN:

THESE SCENES ARE PLAYED OVER THE END CREDITS OF THE SHOW. THEY WILL BE SHOT IN THE STUDIO. THEY ARE SCENES THAT I WOULDN'T NORMALLY DO ON THE ACTUAL SHOW -- THEY COME FROM "THE MIRROR NSFC UNIVERSE!"

INT. WORMHOLE EXTREME! SET
 (NICK, DRAGON)

NICK IS SITTING DOWN AT HIS REGULAR SET FOR WORMHOLE EXTREME! SITTING NEXT TO HIM IS THE HEAD OF A DRAGON WITH THE BODY O.C.

NOTE: The dragon will probably be created and inserted through Adobe After Effects.

DRAGON

(ENGLISH ACCENT) It's dragons like

Smaug that are really giving us all a
bad rap, you know?

NICK

Well, you have to admit that dragons do have a bit of an anger management problem. Right?

DRAGON

WHAT!!!

NICK

Ah crap, I did it again!

NICK GETS BLASTED BY A BURST OF FIRE FROM THE IRATE DRAGON.

NICK (CONTD)

ААААААННННННН!

CUT TO:

INT. GREEN SCREEN SET
 (NICK, KATIE)

NICK AND KATIE ARE DRESSED LIKE FREMEN FROM DUNE. NICK HOLDS KATIE'S HAND AS THEY RUN FROM A SANDWORM OF DUNE/ARRAKIS.

NICK

Come on Katie! Run!

KATIE

(STOPS, FACES NICK) Wait a minute.

Can't you stop it? I thought you were

the Kwisatz Haderach.

NICK

What? Me? No, I'm just Nick of NICK'S SCI-FI CORNER.

KATIE LETS GO. SLAPS NICK IN THE FACE.

KATIE

What! You lied to me! You're on your

own pal!

KATIE RUNS OFF.

NICK

Katie! Don't leave me! I'm scared.

SFX: OMINOUS SOUND OF APPROACHING SANDWORM.

NICK (CONTD)

(CRINGES) Mother.

NICK TURNS AND GETS SUMMARILY DEVOURED BY A SANDWORM.

NICK (CONTD)

ААААААННННННН!

CUT TO:

EXT. DEDHAM TELEVISION - FRONT DOOR - DAY
 (NICK, DONNA, DAN)

C.U. ON THE DEDHAM TV SIGN. WIDE SHOT ON NICK AS HE GOES WALKING INTO THE FRONT DOOR OF THE DEDHAM TELEVISION STUDIO.

NICK

(HUMMING) Spider-Man, Spider-Man, does what ever a spider can ...

MATCH CUT TO:

INT. DEDHAM TELEVISION - DONNA'S OFFICE - CONTINUOUS
NICK WALKS INTO DONNA'S OFFICE. DONNA'S AT HER DESK BUT
SHE'S NOT A HUMAN; INSTEAD, SHE'S AN APE!

NICK

Hey Donna! What's ...

DONNA

Hey Nick! Oh, how are we on the script for the next NICK'S SCI-FI CORNER?

NICK

Ah ... it's coming along great.

DAN THE CAMERAMAN ENTERS DONNA'S OFFICE. HE TOO LOOKS LIKE AN APE!

DAN THE CAMERAMAN

Oh Nick, just the guy I want to see.

NICK TURNS TOWARDS DAN, SURPRISED.

NICK

Ha!

DAN THE CAMERAMAN

Yeah, I've got the Comic-Con footage all uploaded and ready for editing.

NICK

Ah ... thanks Dan.

DONNA

You Okay?

NICK

Yeah sure.

NICK TURNS AND LOOKS INTO A MIRROR ON ONE OF DONNA'S TABLES. HE SEES THAT HE TOO IS AN APE!

NICK (CONTD)

ААААААНННННН!

CUT TO:

EXT. ENDICOTT ESTATE - GAZEBO - DAY
 (NICK, SUSIE, OFFICIANT, APES/ALIENS)

NICK DRESSED IN A PSEUDO-TUX STANDS ACROSS FROM SUSIE PRINCE IN A PSEUDO-WEDDING DRESS HODING A BOUQUET OF FLOWERS. AN OFFICIANT STANDS BETWEEN THEM HOLDING A BINDER. NICK LOOKS DISTRESSED AS THE APES/ALIENS HAVE GUNS/WEAPONS ON HIM.

OFFICIANT

Do you Nick Iandolo of NICK'S SCI-FI CORNER take Susie Prince to be your lawfully wedded wife?

NICK

Ah ... what was the question?

THE APES/ALIENS PROD NICK WITH THEIR GUNS/WEAPONS.

NICK (CONTD)

Ah yes, I do ... I guess.

SUSIE SMILES AND MAKES "CRAZY EYES!"

OFFICIANT

Do you Susie Prince take Nick Iandolo to be your lawfully wedded --

SUSIE

(SCREAMS) -- Yes I do!

OFFICIANT

Okay, I now pronounce you husband and wife, writer and biggest fan -- or,

whatever!

THE APE AND ALIEN CHEER. SUSIE TOSSES THE FLOWERS AT THE OFFICIANT AND LUNGES AT NICK, KISSING HIM. HE TRIES TO HOLD HER BACK.

NICK

Okay, okay, okay, Susie take it easy
... (SHAKES HIS HEAD) Wait a minute,
this isn't right.

SUSIE

Oh yes it is!

SFX: SOUND OF HANDCUFFS CLICKING INTO PLACE

SUSIE MOVES BACK AND NOW NICK AND SUSIE ARE HANDCUFFED TOGETHER. NICK BUG-EYES.

SUSIE (CONTD)

(EVIL SMILE) Now you're mine!

SUSIE PULLS NICK O.C.

NICK

ААААААННННННН!

FADE OUT.
